IMPORTANT — PLEASE READ BEFORE DECORATING!
Your umbrella will be hung upside down as part of the permanent display.

Your artwork must:

- ✓ Be created on the TOP/OUTSIDE surface of the umbrella.
- ✓ Be securely attached to the umbrella.
- ✓ Be able to remain attached while the umbrella is hanging upside down.
- ✓ Use materials that are appropriate for outdoor/community artwork and will not easily fall off.
- ✓ Represent your chosen Redlands-inspired category.
- ✓ Be suitable for public display and family audiences.

PLEASE DO NOT:

- ✗ Attach anything that can easily fall off when the umbrella is turned upside down.
- ✗ Use loose glitter, loose beads, or other materials that could fall onto people below.
- ✗ Add anything sharp, dangerous, or excessively heavy.
- ✗ Decorate the handle or parts of the umbrella that will interfere with hanging.
